2. Apply the 6.8 mm size guideline sticker with the arrow pointing up as shown below. The guideline will help to insure proper head and facial alignment.



3.Slide the bottom cover to open and Insert the provided Flash Air SD labeled **C** into the card slot until it clicks into place. Slide the cover back to close.
